



## Proclamation

WHEREAS, Ed Posh became the first Head Golf Professional at the Village Links of Glen Ellyn when it opened in 1967 as a municipal golf course, creating an environment for golfers of all levels at a place where they could participate in social and competitive events that were typically offered only at private country clubs; and

WHEREAS, in 1968, Posh started the first annual Village Links Junior Championship, later devising an innovative Junior Golf Program, helping hundreds of young students each year learn the game; and

WHEREAS, when Post retired in 1995, the Ed Posh Scholarship Fund was created to honor his many contributions; and


WHEREAS, the purpose of the Scholarship Fund is to financially assist local area youth in attending college or career training; and


WHEREAS, since 1995, the Scholarship Fund has provided over \$600,000 in scholarships to 85 Posh Scholars and 66 have graduated. In 2015, there will be 16 scholars in school collectively receiving \$40,000 in assistance; and


